

## Summary

The majority of KWizCom apps for SharePoint Online require a feature called custom scripting to be enabled. Without it, the app will display an error message when attempting to configure the app settings.

## Resolution

To enable custom scripting, click on the admin button  in the top left of the page >

then click on Admin > Admin centres > SharePoint > Settings. From there, scroll down to the Custom Script section and select the option "Allow users to run custom script on..." for both personal sites/self-service created sites.

### Custom Script

Control whether users can run custom script on personal sites and self-service created sites.  
Note: changes to this setting might take up to 24 hours to take effect.
